ROUTE

The tour is composed of two steps for a total route of 50km along the coastal Rance River. You will start in Dinan, which is both an historical and a cultural city.

On Saturday you will arrive in a small fishermen's village called à St Suliac. On the next day you will go to the lock then back in St Suliac to share a friendly local meal.



SIGHTSEEING

All along the way you will see tide mills, fishing cabins, typical local villages and houses, castles, not to forget the local celebrity, the star of Mordreuc : its seal ! Your tour on the Rance river may also feel like you are travelling in time, from the remains or the Roman age to the fortifications built by John V, Duke of Brittany in the 14th century, and of course the numerous ancient fishing boats which were born there, not to mention the modern creations of our century such as Rance tidal power station. That being said, how can you not then pay a visit to St Malo, the glorious privateer? And what about Dinard? And Dinan? Well, the choice is yours.
