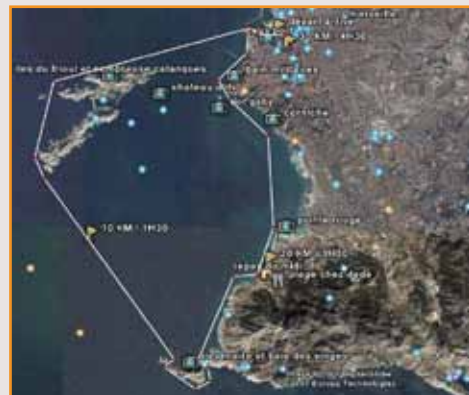
ROUTE

The tour takes place in the amazing natural site which is Marseille harbor. You will depart from the old port, with a view upon old monuments from various centuries, and head towards Ifs castle. You will then navigate on the Goudes' way towards the Maire island and the famous «baie des singes» before diner. You will then end the tour going along the Pointe Rouge cliff to Gaby islet, to finally discover the military baths and the Catalans beach.



SIGHTSEEING

Let's discover Marseilles as the Greek navigators did 2600 years ago. For, in truth, what better way to fully appreciate Marseille than discovering it from the sea, as did Prodis the Phocaeen ? Departing from the old port you will see Notre-Dame-de-la-Garde basilica («la bonne mère») which has protected the inhabitants from its millenary promontory, the forts of St Jean and St Nicolas (designed by Vauban), and St Victor abbey. Afterwards you will pass by the lighthouse palace - which Napoléon III offered the empress Eugénie de Montijo - then getting a glimpse of the «cathédrale de la Major» before finally passing the Ifs castle and of course enjoying many calanques in the process.
