«PETITE SEINE» LOOPS

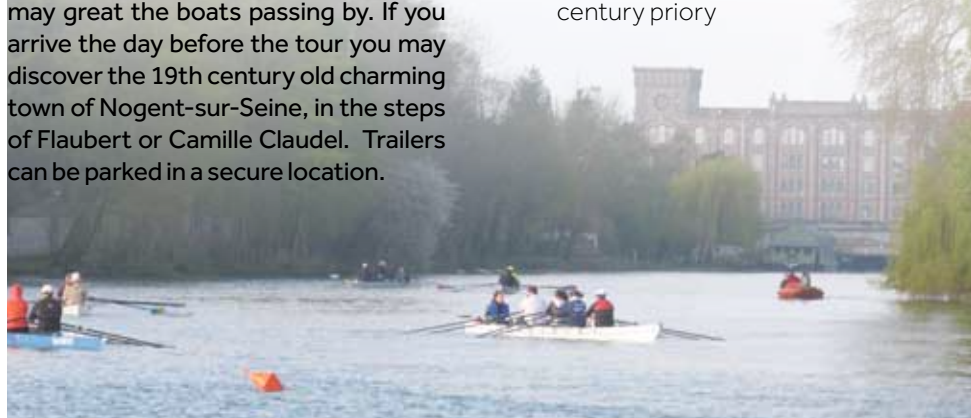
ROUTE

You will start your Petite Seine Loop at Nogent-sur-Seine, which is located at the gates of Aube and Champagne departments. After a 2 km warming up on the Seine, the lock keeper will open for you the Petite Seine doors. You will enjoy this quiet stroll for 9 km with your rider companions for sole company. You will then slow the pace and cross Pont-sur-Seine lift bridge to enjoy Crancey navigable aqueduct. You will have a nice lunch in the heart of a little village of the Vallée de Seine. Once the boats are transferred on the Seine, you will discover the wild side of the river, with its meanders and its fauna. The crews will have to prove their dexterity along the 19 km of a capricious river. The companions will ride on countryside paths among poplar plantations and may greet the boats passing by. If you arrive the day before the tour you may discover the 19th century old charming town of Nogent-sur-Seine, in the steps of Flaubert or Camille Claudel. Trailers can be parked in a secure location.

SIGHTSEEING

The impressive architecture of the SASSOT Mill downstream will amaze you, as the wash house you will leave behind to enter the Petite Seine canal. Its 19th century doors will open and reveal a quiet stroll towards the lift bridge and the Pont canal. Then, leaving behind the civil engineering you will go back on the authentic Seine to discover, along its meanders, discreet villages filled with rich cultural heritage XVII^e.
