ROWING FROM METZ TO NANCY

REQUIRED LEVEL

ROUTE

You will start in the remarkable loop of Liverdun, Nancy's 19th century's Deauville, famous for its 12th century fortified medieval town, its blues waters estate (Art Nouveau) and the Castle of Flie.

Then for the next 56 kilometers you will progress on the Mosell River, either natural or canalized and enlivened with five large locks. After lunch break in Pont à Mousson's club, you will reach Metz by the end of the afternoon on its urban lake where local rowers will greet you in their cozy installations.

SIGHTSEEING

Visiting the region of Lorraine through its two major cities, you will have a perfect opportunity to admire its industrial and historical remnants as well as witness its constant evolution through several modern achievements such as: Stanislas square in Nancy, Pont-à-Mousson's abbey near the local foundry, the high speed train line in Vandières, the roman aqueduct in Jouy aux Arches, Metz in its sanctuary of greenery, with its Chagall designed stained glass, its touristic harbor and of course its brand new Pompidou Center (Contemporary Art Museum) which opened in 2010 and already benefits from a European fame. And at the end of this sporting day you may of course indulge in the local treats: quiche, mirabelle plum, bergamot, macaroons, madeleines (from Liverdun or Commercy) and beer (to drink with care of course).
